

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR SUPPLYING AND DELIVERING OF WATER TREATMENT PLANT SALT FOR WHICH BIDS WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF OAKWOOD UNTIL 2:00 P.M., LOCAL TIME, ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2013.**

**SPECIFICATIONS**

1. Required Characteristics for Normal Usage:
  - High Purity Louisiana Coarse Rock Salt
  - Minimum Sodium Chloride content: 98.5% (dry wt)
  - General Suitability: Acceptable for water-softener regeneration for potable water
  - According to AWWA Standard B200-03
  
2. Delivery Requirement:
  - A. 25 ton minimum order
  - B. Pneumatic type unloading
  - C. The successful bidder shall deliver said salt by tank truck to the storage tanks of the City of Oakwood as and when required during said period. The successful bidder must state the delivery time after receipt of the order. Bulk orders will be no less than 25 tons.
  
3. Estimated Yearly Usage:
  - A. 1200 tons per year
  
4. Storage Capacity:
  - A. Two tanks, at 210 Shafor Boulevard, 1320 cubic feet each  
Two tanks, at 120 Springhouse Road, 2350 cubic feet each
  
5. Pricing  
Bid price is to be firm for the duration of the contract however, in the event there is a decline in the posted per ton price during the period of the contract, the city is to receive the benefit of such decline, or declines.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Director of Engineering and Public Works of the City of Oakwood, in his office, 210 Shafor Boulevard, Dayton, Ohio 45419, until 2:00 P.M. on TUESDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2013 for water treatment plant salt. Price bid must be a firm price good for a period of twelve (12) months beginning January 1, 2014. Alternate bids for a twenty-four (24) month period may also be submitted for consideration.

All bids must be sealed and clearly marked "BIDS FOR WATER TREATMENT PLANT SALT". All bids received by mail must be plainly marked in the same manner and addressed to the Director of Engineering and Public Works, City of Oakwood, 210 Shafor Boulevard, Dayton, Ohio 45419.

Each bid or proposal must be submitted on the Bidder's own proposal blanks, must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting same and must be accompanied by complete specifications. Bidders shall comply with all requirements of law in reference to contracts with political subdivisions of the State of Ohio.

The City of Oakwood reserves the right to waive compliance with any one or more of the requirements of the specifications. The City of Oakwood also reserves the right to accept the bid, which in its opinion is considered the lowest and best bid, to raise or lower quantities, or to reject all bids.
